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Terms and conditions: The drawing competition

Entering the Competition

1. The drawing competition - All about Kids Art ("the Competition") is open to any children aged between five and sixteen years old ("You").
2. To enter the Competition, please submit your favourite drawing.
The "drawing" can also be a writing piece or anything we could print on a T-Shirt.
Drawing size can't exceed 8 1/2 × 11 inches. 4 colours maximum.
3. You can enter the Competition by sharing a picture of your drawing on Instagram @anaisandi, or by emailing us a copy of your drawing at clotilde@anaisandi.com.

PLEASE KEEP THE ORIGINAL DRAWING with you!

Finalists will have to send the original drawing to **anaïs & i, 115 West 30th Street, Suite 704, New York, New York 10001**. You will be responsible for the cost of sending your drawing to us.

4. When submitting your Competition entry, You must provide your name, age and address and the name and contact telephone number of your parent or guardian. We will only use this information in relation to the Competition (including checking your eligibility to enter it) and will not use it for any other purposes whatsoever. We will not keep this information for longer than is necessary for the operation of the Competition.
5. You may only send one entry to the Competition.
6. We must receive your entry to the Competition by 11:59 pm on **28 February 2016**.

Picking the winners

7. **The Design Team** of anaïs & i will first select 5 finalists. Based on the original copy we will receive, they will choose the winner.
8. The winning entries will be those from the longlist that **the Design Team** considers to be the most interesting, creative and original.
9. **The Design Team's** decision will be made on or before **March 8 2016**. The decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

Publishing the winning entries

10. The winning entries will be published on anaïs & i Instagram and Facebook accounts: @anaisandi from March 8 2016 or (if anaïs & i needs to delay this publication for any reason) at a later date.
11. You own the copyright to your Competition entry as its author.

12. By submitting an entry to the Competition, You give anaïs & i: a. 19. We will substitute the T-Shirt with other prizes of similar value in the event that the original prize offered is not available.
